

Wallet/Purse Safety Checklist

Protecting the contents of your wallet or purse:

- PIN numbers should be memorised and never kept anywhere within your wallet or written on the cards themselves.
- Only keep the smallest amount of cash that you require at any given time in your wallet. That way, the losses are minimised if your wallet is lost or stolen.
- Keep a record of phone numbers and addresses for each bank/credit card company that you have a product with. If you go on holiday or stay away from home for any length of time, ensure that you have these details with you.
- Only carry your chequebook with you if it's completely necessary. If you must carry your chequebook, don't keep it in the same wallet as your ID.

Minimise the risk of losing your wallet/purse:

- Never leave your wallet or purse unattended in your car.
- Never leave your wallet or purse on show in crowded public areas, and avoid keeping them in your back pocket.
- Do not leave your wallet or purse in any items of clothing that you hang up or leave unattended.
